1°) Admission

To be admitted to enter and stay on a campsite, you have to be expressly authorized by the manager of the campsite or his representative. To stay on the campsite implies acceptance of this regulation and commitment to comply.

We remind you that the campsite is strictly reserved for clients who are on holidays and not to make it their home.

2°) Registration

Every client has to check in at the reception and pay the total amount of his stay upon arrival. Arrivals are available between 4 pm and 7 pm for mobile homes and plots. Clients who have rented a mobile home need to pay local taxes upon arrival.

3°) Opening Times

The site is open from 7.00 am to 10 pm. For security reasons, these opening times may be modified by the manager without notice.

The reception is open every day from 9.00 am to 1.00 pm and 3 pm to 5 pm in low season, from 8.00 am to 1.00 pm and 3.00 pm to 7.00 pm in July and August.

In case of emergency, you can always contact a doctor during reception opening times. A notice board outside the office will give you all the information and numbers in case of emergency.

When the reception is closed, please ring the bell next to the office door or call: 04 94 70 00 93 (number of the Campsite)

4°) Noise

« Everyone's freedom is limited by the freedom of others ». Noise can be everyone's enemy and even more so when on holiday. Please try to respect others by not being noisy and especially after 10 pm (low season) and 11 pm in July and August. Any violation of this rule will result in eviction from the camp.

5°) Rules for the swimming pool

SWIMMING POOL IS STRICTLY RESERVED TO CLIENTS. It is open from 10.00 am to 7.00 pm. Opening hours could be changed if necessary, in case of special climate conditions.

Don't forget! Shorts and Bermuda shorts are strictly forbidden in the swimming pool and babies must wear a nappy especially for the swimming pool.

The swimming pool is not supervised. Children, when they are at the swimming pool, whatever the activity, they are the unique responsibility of their parents or representatives.

6°) Visitors

Visitors are accepted in the camp in accordance with the Direction. The campers who have invited them must supervise them. They must respect rules and regulations and must pay a fee to use campsite facilities. Visitors are not permitted to bring their vehicle into the campsite. There is a parking outside the camp.

7°) Campsite circulation

The speed limit on the camp site is 10 km/hour.

However, from 9 pm in low season and 10 pm in July and August, you are requested to park your car in the car park situated by the camp entrance (you are responsible for your own car).

Guests are not permitted to bring their vehicles into the Camp site. If you have a second car, please park your car in the car park situated by the camp entrance.

8°) Be Clean and Tidy

Please make use of the dustbins. Household waste, other rubbish and papers must be disposed of in the dustbins. A recycling system exists at the camp site exit.

Please use the basins provided for your washing. Please respect the greenery and flowerbeds. It is forbidden to stick nails into the trees, cut branches or plant anything of your own. You are not permitted to mark out your pitch by personal means, nor to dig into the ground. Anyone who causes damage to the campsite plants, fences, ground or facilities will be responsible for the cost of the repairs. The pitch used by campers during their stay must be kept in the state in which the found it on arrival.

9°) Security

a) Barbecues:

Gas barbecues are the only barbecues authorized on the campsite

b) Theft:

The direction is responsible for all values locked up in the safe of the campsite and the obligation of the direction concerns the means in term of supervision the campsite. Campers are responsible for their own installation. They must inform the direction in case of any suspicious person.

Campers are advised to take the usual precautions concerning their own equipment.

10°) Playground

Children are the unique responsibility of their parents when they play games in the playground. We cannot be held responsible for any accident.

11°) Electricity

You can use the provided electricity to power your refrigerators, kitchen equipment, razors, televisions, radios and lighting for your caravan. All other electrical appliances are forbidden, because they can overload your caravan and your neighbour's electricity circuit. On each pitch, there is 10 amps and up to 40 amps in mobile homes.
